


Why the EMPA?

Executive Master of Public Policy (EMPP)

- EMPA and EMPP share the same curriculum
- EMPA and EMPP students are taught in the same classroom for 75% of the programme – exception, Policy in Practice Workshops
- EMPP sponsored programme for senior levels of UK Civil Service Policy Profession
- Future leaders of UK Civil Service
- Drawn from major UK government departments
- Estimated intake 25 30.
